Formerly called the Burnaby Association for the Emotionally Disabled, the Society provides affordable housing and support services for adults living with mental illness. The Society strives to work within the bounds of respect, ethics, partnerships, empathy and teamwork. This approach assists people living with mental illness live independently within the city of Burnaby.

The Society has also established the Homeless Outreach Program. This program aim to form relationships with homeless individuals and provide them with support services to help them make the next step to find housing, income assistance, health services and social service programs.

The Society has established a wide range of housing options, such as:

- Supported Independent Living
- Community Living Support Program
- Shared Housing Program
- Gilmore Transition Program

The Progressive Housing Society programs are based on the principles of recovery and psychosocial rehabilitation.
