Hope for Freedom Society is staffed by dedicated, full time, professionally trained counsellors and facilitators, together with a staff of volunteers and resource people in related fields. They provide daily access to structured treatment, with group and one-on-one counselling for addiction and related problems. Drug and alcohol education, life skills courses in communication, spiritual direction and motivation are also provided.

Hope for Freedom Society earnestly believes that complete recovery is possible for any addict who is willing. They head our men's program under Resurrection House and women's program under Glory House. Both provide a physically and emotionally safe environment filled with acceptance and care. These houses nurture the hope and desire for freedom from addiction. We work towards this goal together with the support of the community, and by the grace of God.

Recently the Hope for Freedom Society was given approval to establish a cold or wet weather mat program during the winter at the Coquitlam Alliance Church, Eagle Ridge Bible Fellowship and Calvary Baptist Church. These three locations have also been used as emergency shelters for the homeless population the past three years.
