

Working to Solve Homelessness:

Surrey North Community Health Centre



“Helping Those in Need”

Located at 10697 – 135A Street in Surrey, near the Front Room Drop-In Centre, the Surrey North Community Health Centre, provides general health services every weekday afternoon to community members whether or not they have medical coverage. The Health Centre serves the South Fraser Region including, but not limited to, Surrey, Delta, White Rock, Langley City and the Township of Langley.

While most of the people using the clinic are homeless, the clinic also assists refugees and others who, for a variety of reasons, do not have medical coverage.

The part-time doctors and nurses staffing the clinic provide a wide range of health care services including on-site testing and counseling for sexually transmitted diseases, pregnancy, hepatitis, and HIV/AIDS, a needle exchange program, and referrals to drug and alcohol treatment programs.
